Juvenile Trial Wins

A juvenile defendant was convicted of aggravated battery on a fellow teenager. In this case, the defendant got into an argument with the seventeen year old victim and threw boiling water on her. As a result, the victim suffered serious burns that will leave scars on her chest and back for the rest of her life. This juvenile defendant was already on probation for battery and theft and will now likely receive a lengthy commitment sentence.

Another juvenile was convicted of trespass on school grounds with a deadly weapon. He was a former student at Baldwin High School who, on the day of his arrest, chose to ride a school bus to the school and walked into a classroom. The defendant had a bag containing a large steel pipe and a Bowie knife.
